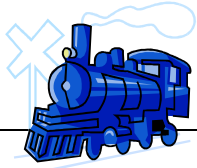

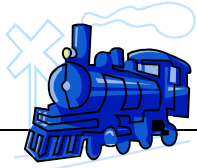
NETBALL REPORT
