### **APPA Music Festival**

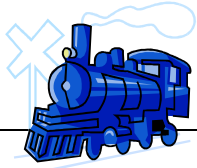

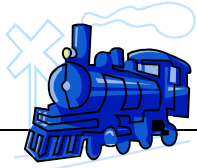
