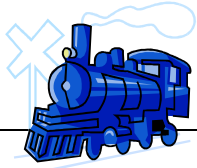

Calf Club Day Informative Meeting

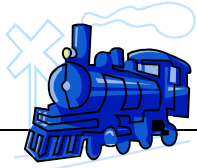

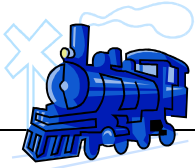

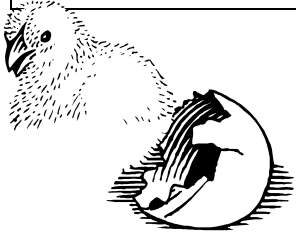
